



## Info for Open/Deep Water Rescue Kayak Class

Below is a list of items you will need to bring/wear to the upcoming Open/Deep Water Rescue Kayak Class. Directions and driving times can be found via the Googlemaps link on our website. Our meeting location is a primitive access and therefore does not have a toilet, changing rooms, potable water, etc. Please take care of things prior to arriving. Please do not hesitate to call if you have any other questions.

### What to Bring/Wear:

- quick dry clothing appropriate for expected temperatures and that you do not mind being in and out of the water with.
- wind breaker
- Teva style sandals or water shoes
- sunblock
- sunglasses
- hat
- bug repellent
- 2 quart water (minimum) and snack
- full change of clothes
- towel
- notebook to take notes during class (optional)

Again, please consult a map or Googlemaps (link can be found on our website) to estimate how long the drive will take you to reach the put-in from your departure point.

### Directions to the West Point Outpost Access

Follow the Googlemaps directions (link on our website). As you near the access refer to the info below to help find our meet location

- To reach the Outpost you will need to turn into the West Point on the Eno City Park. This turn is at a stoplight.
- Follow the park road around all the way to the West Point Mill. Across the grassy field from the mill you will see a rack of boats where you will meet for this class.

### Directions to Falls Lake, Beaver Dam Primitive Access

Follow the Googlemaps directions (link on our website). As you near the access refer to the info below to help find our meet location

- To reach the primitive access you will need to turn onto the bumpy dirt road on the south side of Old Weaver Trail.
- Follow this road a hundred yards or so to the water. You should then see a Frog Hollow vehicle and kayaks parked here. The GPS coordinates at the top of this page mark the turn off of Old Weaver Trail onto this dirt road.



## Directions to Ferrington Point Access

Follow the Googlemaps directions (link on our website). As you near the access refer to the info below to help find our meet location

- From Farrington Rd look for the big grey Farrington Point Access sign (facing the road) and the Wildlife Resources Commission sign with the big black and white diamond on it. Please keep a sharp eye out for it.
- Turn here, **stay to the left on the driveway**, you will come down to the boat ramp and see a Frog Hollow truck and trailer

## Cancellation Policy

- **Cancellations within one week prior to a trip or class** - Registrants will be refunded half of their total registration fee.
- **Cancellations within 1 day prior to a trip or class date** - Registrants will be charged in full.
- **“No shows” or late arrivals for a trip or class** - Registrants will be charged in full.
- **Cancellations due to weather related or hazardous conditions** - Registrants will receive a full credit with Frog Hollow equal to their total trip or class registration that can be used anytime within 1 year of the cancelled trip or class. Refunds are not given.
- **Changing or shifting a trip or class date** – Registrants may shift or change the date of their trip or class at any time. If a date shift or change is made within the week prior to a scheduled trip or class there is a \$5 (per boat) service fee.
